It is agreed that the lessee will hire the above mentioned instrument in the condition as recorded on the back of this page from the lessor under the following conditions :

1. The instrument and accessories will remain the property of the lessor for the duration of the lease after which it will be returned to the lessor in the same condition as when it was leased.
2. The lessee remains responsible for the instrument until it is inspected and accepted back by the the lessor and a receipt has been issued. **BE SURE TO INSIST ON THIS RECEIPT. WITHOUT IT YOU HAVE NO PROOF THAT YOU HAVE RETURNED THE INSTRUMENT.**
3. The fee for the lease is R2200 , (two, two, zero, zero rand only)per annum, payable in 11 installments of R200, (two, zero, zero rand only)per month. (This fee will increase annually as agreed to during the annual parents meeting)
4. The term of the contract depends on the continuation of tuition at the Musikon and can therefore not be predicted
5. The lessee accepts responsibility for the safety and care of the instrument. This comprise of the following :
 - 5.1 The instrument must be insured for at least R_____, (_____) . The reason being that it must be replaced if it is stolen or irreplaceably damaged. The recommended amount is only an estimate and not necessarily the actual price as this is subject to change.
 - 5.2 **NO REPAIR WORK IS ALLOWED TO BE DONE PRIVATELY.** When damaged or troublesome, the instrument must be handed in at the Musikon immediately. General maintenance will be done free of charge **BUT** in the case of an instrument being damaged through negligence, the lessee will be held responsible for the cost of the repair
 - 5.3 Consumables such as reeds, rosin, oil, grease, broken string replacement etc. are not supplied: those are for the account of the lessee.
 - 5.4 Full instructions as to care of the instrument are taught and appears in the student's handbook.

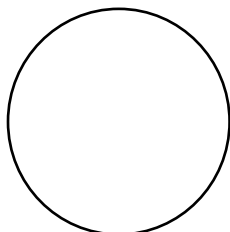
